### INVITATION TO Re-BID

The Iligan City Government Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), through 20% Development Fund intend to apply the sum of P 1,401,333.78 being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the Contract for **COMPLETION OF 2-STOREY MULTI-PURPOSE HALL FOR SENIOR CITIZENS, BRGY. TUBOD, ILIGAN CITY** with Project No. CB(B)-23-149 (CEO-INFRA)Re-bid. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Delivery period is within Fifty Five (55) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed, within two (2) year from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino Citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from Iligan City government and inspect the Bidding Documents during office hours from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. at the Office of the Bids and Awards Committee, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor City Hall Main Bldg., Buhanginan Hills, Pala-o, Iligan City.


